John Payne will be interviewed by David Bishop whilst visiting in Canada. John is a Pastor in the New Frontiers Church and will talk about leaving the UK to live in Vancouver to church plant just before Covid hit the world and how that has been affected.

March 23rd

Archbishop Philip Richardson, Primate and Archbishop of the New Zealand Dioceses. He will talk about the New Zealand church with its unique organisational structure and the impact of climate change which is particularly felt by the Polynesian communities.
