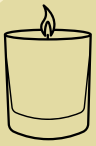
October PCC Focus

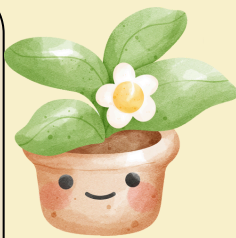
Harvest Lunch
