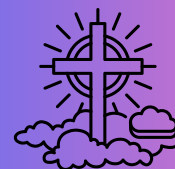

Spotlight on: APCM

The APCM (Annual Parochial Church Meeting) is an important yearly gathering where we come together as a church family to reflect on the past year (2025) and look ahead with hope. During the service, we give thanks for all that God has done, hear updates on the life and ministry of the church, and review key reports such as our finances, safeguarding and repairs to our church. It is also when we elect members to serve as trustees on the PCC (Parochial Church Council), helping to shape the future direction and mission of our church. It's both a time of worship and a moment of shared responsibility in the life of the church. This service is suitable for children and takes place on **Sunday 17th May at 10am; it replaces the 9.30 and 11am service on that day.**

Counting Day

On **Friday 22nd May** between **2pm and 6pm** why not pop down to church and help us count our stuff? Each year we need to audit our inventory and check how many of each thing we have; for example how many hymn books or forks or chairs.
